

ALENTEJO

Alentejo is well worth getting to know. All that is said about the Alentejo is true: light, unrelenting sun, dryness, endless undulating plains, cork trees and holm-oaks, wine and olive oil, bread sauces and lamb stews, coriander and purslane, big modern wines and old clay-pot fermented reds; good, hospitable folk.

Once upon a time, Alentejo vines were cultivated by Phoenicians, Greeks and Romans. Nowadays they are grown on vast farms and wine producing estates and their wines have put the name Alentejo among the best wines in Portugal, while its culinary tradition is regarded as one of the most tasty and original. A world of different flavours that requires time to understand and appreciate, just like the rest of the Alentejo.





CASA RELVAS

Casa Relvas was established in 1997 in São Miguel de Machede, Redondo, under the guidance of **Alexandre Relvas**, who recognised the expansive horizons of his African heritage in the "Herdade de São Miguel." Driven by a profound love for Alentejo and a genuine admiration for its distinctive terroir, the initial phase of this venture involved the reforestation of cork trees, emblematic of the region.



However, it was within the vineyards, a cultural tradition spanning over two millennia in the area, where our true passion was unveiled.

Presently, the family manages a total of 350 hectares of vineyards, 900 hectares of forest, and 250 hectares of olive groves. They produce over 6 million bottles per year, 70% of which are exported to more than 30 countries. In the last 10 years, their wines have won more than 500 gold medals in international competitions and have received the highest scores throughout trade press.








DOURO

There are few wine-growing landscapes as stunning as Douro's. This region boasts dazzling scenery, shape and is influenced by the Douro river, which flows from Barea d'Alva to Porto.

Viticulture dates back to the Roman occupation. Centuries of human toil & fatigue ensued. The Douro territory occupies 620,000 acres of land. In 1756, the Douro became the first demarcated wine region in the world, thanks to the Marquis of Pompal.

Nowadays the region is as well known for its quality table wines as it is for the cultivation of its port wines, famous throughout the world. A must visit place.





QUINTA DO VALE MEÃO

In 1877, **Antonia Adelaide Ferreira**, owner of the largest winemaking estate in the Douro, purchased 300 hectares of virgin land at auction from the Vila Nova de Foz Coa municipality. Her dream was to create a model vineyard from nothing, using for this the vast experience she had acquired throughout a lifetime as a Douro landowner. This project took eight years to complete, from 1887 to 1895.

In the 1970s, her great-great-great-grandson, **Francisco Javier de Olazabal** became responsible for its management. In 1994, he and his children became the sole owners of the Quinta. Until then, the grapes from the estate were sold to **A.A. Ferreira S.A.**, the company established by Dona Antonia's descendants, where they formed the basis of some of its finest wines.

This connection continued until 1998 when **Francisco Javier de Olazabal** resigned as Managing Director of **A.A. Ferreira S.A.** to dedicate himself, together with his oenologist son **Francisco de Olazabal y Nicolau de Almeida**, to producing, ageing, and marketing the wines from the Quinta through a new company, **F. Olazabal & Filhos Lda.**



The Dão wine region, nestled in the heart of Portugal, is renowned for producing some of the country's most elegant and characterful wines. Situated in the mountainous interior, its unique terroir is shaped by granite soils and a temperate climate influenced by both Atlantic and continental factors. Here, indigenous grape varieties like Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, and Jaen thrive, crafting wines with a distinct balance of fruitiness, acidity, and minerality. Known for its red wines, Dão also produces notable whites, often exhibiting crisp acidity and floral aromatics. With a long winemaking tradition dating back centuries, Dão continues to captivate wine enthusiasts with its refined expressions of Portuguese viticulture.





MOB WINES DÃO REGION

This project arises from the desire of three winemakers, Jorge Moreira, Francisco Olazabal, and Jorge Serôdio Borges, to make a wine together. The chosen region was Dão, a region for which we share a common admiration that originated from tasting older wines from the 1960s and 1970s, which surprise us with their elegance and freshness.

The identity and complexity of these wines are indeed remarkable and serve as inspiration for us to create our MOB, whether they are white or red.

To realize this project, we took advantage of the opportunity that arose with the lease of Quinta do Corujão. Comprising two distinct vineyards, it is located in one of the coolest areas of the region in Seia, at the foot of the Serra da Estrela.

The combination of altitude, soils, and grape varieties of this property convinced us that it would be the right place to move forward. In 2013, another small property located in Gouveia with four hectares of old vines was leased.





The Peninsula de Setúbal region is steeped in vine-growing tradition and is the realm of two famed grape varieties: the red Castelao and the white Moscatel.







We prefer not to work to a set timetable, but rather observe and react to the ever-changing climate, the development of the vines and the maturity of the fruit, organising the work on a what needs to be done basis throughout the year.

ABOUT PERCHERON WINES

A contemporary range of wines celebrating the history of draft horses in South African viticulture and the ancient vines they once tended to. A breed of French, heavy horses, Percheron horses were regularly used in the vineyard many years ago. This practise is enjoying a resurgence in South Africa as the horses' hooves are gentler to the soil and they fit easily between the closely planted old vines without damaging the plants.



The Percheron wines are made exclusively from old-vine fruit, grown in sites discovered by winemaker Ryno Byoosen in the farthest flung corners of the Cape, many of which were first established in Percheron horses' heyday. These are contemporary wines celebrating traditional South African cultivars and the re-introduction of the Percheron to work the vineyards.
