The Scarecrow story begins in a patch of earth with a fabled past. The J.J. Cohn Estate, where Scarecrow grapes are born, borders what was once the legendary vineyard of Inglenook winemaker Gustave Niebaum, whose plantings blanketed more than 1,000 acres of Napa Valley at the close of the 19th century. John Daniel Jr. took the helm at Inglenook in 1939, determined to restore the label to pre-Prohibition standing and produce world-class Bordeaux-style wines.

In 1945, Daniel convinced his neighbor, J.J. Cohn to plant eighty acres of Cabernet Vines on the 180-acre parcel Cohn had purchased a few years prior. Daniel promised to buy his grapes, so Cohn planted vines. The rest, as they say, is history. J.J. Cohn grapes are highly sought-after in part because Cohn bucked the trend, begun in the mid-1960s, of replacing vines planted on St. George rootstock with the supposedly superior AxR#1 hybrid. Over time, vines grafted onto this new stock proved highly vulnerable to phylloxera. But by then virtually all of the old St. George vines in Napa had been destroyed. Only the original 1945 J.J. Cohn vines survived.

These highly prized “Old Men” continue to produce uncommonly rich fruit—the hallmark of Scarecrow wine.

One of the most famous wines to come out of California, Scarecrow has established a cult following with demand that vastly outstrips supply—at a 2009 Premiere Napa Valley auction, a lot of five cases was sold for \$80,000, and in 2011, five cases sold for a record-breaking \$125,000. The Scarecrow name comes from JJ Cohn, MGM executive producer of The Wizard of Oz, who acquired the property in 1943. Celia Welch oversees the annual production of 800 cases from only 2 acres of 45-year-old vines.

Owner Bret Lopez was born in Los Angeles in 1948 and catapulted at age fifteen into a career as a professional photographer, Bret grew up relishing vacations at his grandfather J.J. Cohn’s summer home in Rutherford. He has returned to the Napa Valley to honor his family heritage and to fulfill the promise of the J.J. Cohn Estate in the exceptional wine that is Scarecrow.

A gem in the heart of Stags Leap District, Silverado Vineyards has embarked on its fourth decade of producing estate-grown, produced, and bottled fine wines. The third and fourth generations of the Miller family continue the legacy.

Silverado Vineyard was one of the first four in Stags Leap District to plant Cabernet in the 1960s. The winery owns five other storied vineyards across Napa Valley’s top AVAs: Miller Ranch in Yountville, Mt. George in Coombsville, Soda Creek/Borreo Ranch, and both Firetree and Vineburg in Carneros. The estate is comprised of over 600 acres. Forty percent of the land is preserved, and 360 acres are sustainably farmed and certified Napa Green.

Winemaker Jon Emmerich is tasked with evoking a sense of place in the estate wines produced from these contrasting and historic vineyard sites. In 2020, Jon celebrated his 30th anniversary with the winery, and his counterpart, associate winemaker Elena Franceschi celebrated her 25th anniversary. Together, they have grown Silverado Vineyards’ reputation for quality and consistency. **Sustainable**

Winemaking at Cerbaiona is straightforward. The grapes are harvested by hand and pressed in a vintage wood-sided press before fermenting in cement tanks. After a period of settling, the Brunello spends 4+ years in cask and at least 6 months in bottle before release. Nothing is added; no yeasts, no enzymes—and nothing is subtracted; no fining, no filtration

With winemaking this straightforward, the explanation for the greatness of Diego's Brunello must lie with the tiny 3-ha vineyard. While much is written about the difference between northern and southern Montalcino wines, Cerbaiona lies in an intermediate zone. Consequently, the vineyard yields beautiful fruit which balances the south's ripeness with the freshness and structure of the north.

The story of the Marqués de Murrieta winery is inextricably intertwined with the history of Rioja wine. The winery's founder, the Marqués de Murrieta, imported production techniques into Spain from Bordeaux. In 1852 he produced his first wine in Logroño, moving into the Ygay Estate in the late 1870s. Located at the heart of La Rioja, the estate is home to Ygay Castle, headquarters of the Marqués de Murrieta wineries. The castle is surrounded by 300 hectares of vineyards.

In 1983 Cebrián-Sagariga family took up the mantle, commencing in 2007 meticulous restoration work on Ygay Castle which was finished in 2014, the year the winery reopened its doors. Visitors can now enjoy guided tours beginning in the vineyard, continuing through renovated century-old areas, and culminating in a professional tasting of the winery's wines.

Clos de l'Obac is a wine of extraordinary power, structure and complexity. These characteristics are the result of the diversity of orientations and altitudes of seven vineyards located around the town of Gratallops, and planted with vines of Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot, and Garnacha and Cariñena planted over 50 years ago. In 1979 Carles Pastrana and Mariona Jarque recovered the family winemaking tradition, and started off on a long adventure aimed to rescue the old Carthusian wines in the heart of the lands that were once under the dominion of the priors of Scala Dei, a monastery located in the Catalan region of El Priorat. Carles and Mariona created the properties of Clos de l'Obac and Miserere, replanting vines along the banks of the river Siurana in the southern pre-coastal area of Catalonia.

Artadi is a well-regarded, high-profile wine producer based in the Rioja Alavesa town of Laguardia although famously having left the local Rioja wine body, it produces wines under the Vino de Mesa title. It makes a range of Rioja-style wines albeit with a subregional focus and is perhaps best-known for its single vineyard labels, all made from Tempranillo.

The single vineyard labels include El Carretil, La Poza de Ballesteros, Quintanilla, San Lazaro and Valdegines, as well as the flagship El Pison. The 2004 vintage of El Pison wine received 100 points from American wine critic Robert Parker.

Other notable wines include the Pagos Viejos cuvée, the value-level Viñas de Gain and the entry-level Artadi Joven, produced from carbonically macerated Tempranillo and Viura. Artadi also makes a white Viñas de Gain from 100 percent Viura aged in oak as well as a sparkling Cava, also from local Viura. **Organic**

The producer began life in 1985 as a cooperative of 13 growers with well-situated vineyards around Laguardia. The vineyards and winery were purchased in 1992 by fourth-generation local winegrower Juan Carlos López de Lacalle and in the subsequent decades, the wines garnered much international critical and consumer appeal.

In 2016, Lacalle famously withdrew Artadi from the Rioja wine trade body following a progressive move to more subregional designations (even single vineyard mentions) on the winery's labels – a move outlawed by current regional legislation.

López de Lacalle's wines are fruit-driven and characterized by smooth tannins, showing an emphasis on individual vineyard sites more than aging styles. He also owns the El Sequé estate in Alicante, which makes wine from the Monastrell variety, and Artazu in Navarra, which focuses on the Garnacha grape. **Organic**

Leeuwin Estate, one of the founding wineries of the now famous Margaret River district, consistently produces wines that rank with the world's finest. In 1972, following an extensive search for the area most suitable to produce the best varietal wines in Australia, legendary American winemaker, Robert Mondavi, identified the future site of the Leeuwin vineyard. Originally a cattle farm, Leeuwin Estate evolved, under the direction of Denis and Tricia Horgan, with Robert Mondavi acting as consultant and mentor. A nursery was planted in 1974 and the initial vineyards were deep-ploughed, deep-ripped, emptied of stone, planned, pegged, measured, marked and eventually planted by hand over a five year period from 1975. Featuring state-of-the-art facilities, the winery building was opened in 1978, celebrating with a trial vintage. Leeuwin enjoyed its first commercial vintage in 1979, and was thrust into the international spotlight when Decanter Magazine gave its highest recommendation to the 1980 "Art Series" Chardonnay in an international blind tasting.

Critics call it the first Super Rhône. Chêne Bleu's vineyards sit at a crossroads of four Rhône Appellations near Gigondas, at a higher elevation around 550m. The vineyards are isolated by topography, with no neighbours, and surrounded by trees in a UNESCO protected biome. The terrain shields the vineyards from pollution and drifting agricultural chemicals, providing a pristine foundation for the estate's biodynamic viticulture. Chêne Bleu's wines do not fit stylistically into the surrounding appellations, so they are presented as Vins de Pays, earning them the Super Rhône moniker. "We're basically on the same latitude as Châteauneuf-du-Pape, so we get a great expression of fruit," said Nicole Rolet, owner and GM of the estate, "but because we're at altitude, we have one foot in the Northern Rhône as well, stylistically." **Biodynamic**

Imagine, at an altitude of 200 metres, in the heart of the forests, a magnificent amphitheatre on precious groundwater that naturally hydrates the cultures, even in case of prolonged drought. An ideal situation, attested for centuries by the given name of the place where the vineyard is located: “Favori”.

It is said that rosé was invented in Provence. In any case, the Romans had already planted their vines there to make rosé, the Templars developed agriculture in the region, which then experienced a tremendous boom growth shortly before the Napoleonic era, as evidenced by the kilometres of restanques (traditional walls made of local stones) and the remains of drainage and irrigation systems. Generations of winegrowers have perpetuated this rich past, selling their crops to a local trader.

The philosophy of Château FAVORI for the cultivation and wine production is simple: to ensure that nature has the optimal conditions to provide the best it has to offer. To implement this vision: organic cultivation, symbiosis with the land, reconstruction and modernisation of the remains of the irrigation/drainage systems, intelligent use of the energies and resources of the terroir. **Organic**

The Left Bank of Bordeaux is known for creating a wine blend with stronger flavors of Cabernet Sauvignon over Merlot. Most left Bank Bordeaux wines are known to be a bit more powerful and tannic than those on the Right Bank. They typically offer notes of dark fruit, cassis, and coffee, among others. Due to the higher presence of tannins, Left Bank Bordeaux wines benefit greatly from aging. There are many AOCs within the Left Bank, but none are more famous than Medoc, which contains over five hundred different vineyards.

Gravel and Sand: As these soils warm with sun exposure, they radiate heat back up into the vine canopy and help to ripen the grapes by keeping the ambient temperature above the 10c minimum required for photosynthesis. This proves invaluable in the cool, but sunny evening hours of the late autumn and in the sunny, cool mornings of spring. Gravel yields wines with firm tannins, structure and aromatics. Sandy soil yields more opulent, soft and fruit-forward wine with easy drinkability

The Right Bank of Bordeaux is known for favoring Merlot over Cabernet Sauvignon in its blend. These wines are slightly less tannic than their Left Bank counterparts and make a great introduction to Bordeaux wines. A few popular Right Bank AOCs are Saint-Émilion and Pomerol.

Clay and Limestone: As these soils are both dense and moisture-retaining, they do not hasten the ripening process. Clay, much of which is iron-rich here, produces wines with notes of prune and walnut. Limestone produces wines with pronounced acidity and lean, polished tannins.

A passion for wine drove Charles Lorentz' Father to focus on excellence by developing his vineyard on the Altenberg hillside in Bergheim. Historically, the harvests from these hills with exceptional potential are vinified separately. Thus Riesling, Pinot-Gris, Gewurztraminer and other Muscats native to this Altenberg express this region's unique character from vintage to vintage. The result of this persistent obstinacy was the classification of the vineyard to the rank of Grand Cru in 1983. The second of the Grands Crus owned, more modest in size, is the Kanzleberg. A rich heir to a long history linked to the Knights of St John and the Order of the Templar, it allows, on its gypsum marl soil, expression of the complex finesse of the Riesling, and more recently the Pinot Gris.

Once the garden of Roman Gaul, the Vaucluse is bathed in sunlight nearly all year long. At 350 meters elevation, the vineyards of Domaine du Tix are blessed with hot days, cool nights and dewy mornings. The clay-and-limestone soil is ideal for traditional varieties of Rhone grape, including syrah, grenache, cinsault, and viognier. It is a demanding terroir that stimulates the vines.
