## **BREAKING THE CYCLE OF HABITUAL SIN: IS THERE ANY HOPE?**

OR HOW CAN I HELP A FRIEND BREAK FREE? OUR LORD GRACIOUSLY OFFERS A WAY OUT. COME DISCOVER HOW THE CYCLE OF HABITUAL SIN CAN BE BROKEN.
