ASSOCIATE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR, PRODUCER, AND CHOREOGRAPHER

Originally from Kailua, Hawaii, Kaili is a dancer, choreographer, now educator currently based in Dallas, TX under the representation of Bloc Talent Agency. Dancing throughout her childhood all over the United States'she realized she wanted to pursue a career in the entertainment industry. She was fortunate enough at an early age of 17 to kick start her career on America's Best Dance Crew with Request Dance Crew under the directional Parris Goebel. Since then Kaili has toured the world with Justin Bieber on his Believe Tour, you may have also seen her dancing alongside many artists including, Adele, Ariana Grande, Rihanna, Pink, Kelly Clarkson, FKA Twigs, Kanye West, Jennifer Lopez, Fifth Harmony, Jason Derulo, Hailee Steinfeld. You definitely cannot miss Kaili onstage. You most likely have seen Kaili dance at the superbowl, on televised shows, live shows and award shows including The Grammys, the Billboard Awards, Radio Disney Music Awards, Coachella, to name a few. Most recently you can catch Kaili in any one of Rihanna's Savage X Fenty Shows on Amazon. Kaili is currently the associate artistic director for the Joffrey Ballet School full time Trainee program and has worked with the Dallas Cowboy Cheerleaders in Dallas. Kaili hopes to bring her unique style combining performance, and a fusion of technique and hip hop to the new generation of talent across the globe.



GIOVANNI ALLEN CHOREOGRAPHER AND FACULTY

Giovanni Allen is originally from New York City, where he received his early training at the Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater and American Ballet Theater. He did his undergraduate work at California Institute for the Arts in LA. In 2008, he was invited to choreograph at the Barcelona International Course of Dance in Spain, as well as the Greece Dance Festival. He has worked with artists such as; Rodolfo Castellanos, Jean Emile, Juan Borona and Roger Jeffrey. After Spain, he was chosen to represent Cal Arts at the American College Dance Festival in 2009. That same year he was cast in the NYC broadway holiday show "Radio City Christmas Spectacular". In the summer of 2010, he made Texas home, where he has been teaching modern, lyrical, contemporary, hip-hop, jazz, and ballet and choreographing for numerous studios in the Metroplex. Giovanni has made a name for himself in the Dallas area. He has choreographed numerous award winning dances. He brings that certain "spark" to every class and piece of work. He draws from a large range of influences such as musical, literary, social and even nature. His goal is to simply spread his vision and teachings all over the world. Giovanni has also judged for numerous pro dance teams and dance competitions. He is very pleased and honored to be a part of the SoulDeSoul Dance Convention as well as the Assistant Director of the Pedestrian Dance Movement. Giovanni was recently invited to be a Guest Instructor in Portugal in the Dance World Cup.

Sean trained with Goh Ballet Academy, Ballet British Columbia's Mentor Program and The Ailey School. He has performed with Ballet Creole (Toronto, Canada), Bruce Wood Dance Project (Dallas, Texas), Rhythmic Souls Tap Company, African American Repertory Theater and Dallas Black Dance Theatre where he danced for 14 seasons and also served as Rehearsal Director. Sean has performed with Dallas Theater Center in The Wiz (2011) and Hairspray (2018). Throughout his career, Sean has had the joy and privilege to perform works choreographed by Alvin Ailey, Elisa Monte, Francesca Harper, Norbert De La Cruz III, Claude Alexander III, Christopher L. Huggins, Donald McKayle, Darrell Grand Moultrie, Talley Beatty, David Parsons, Bridget L. Moore, Jae Man Joo and Matthew Rushing, among many others. Sean teaches Classical Ballet, Tap, and the Dance Technique of Lester Horton. Sean has taught for Ailey Athletic Boys, Poirier Productions (Vancouver, Canada), Dallas Black Dance Academy, Ambition Dance Productions, Centre for Dance, The Dallas Conservatory, and Southern Methodist University, Sean has chargeagaphed and Southern Methodist University. Sean has choreographed three works for Dallas Black Dance Theatre: Monologues (2013), Interpretations (2017) and Swipe Left (2023) and one work for DBDT: Encore!, Dollhouse (2015). Sean also choreographed and conceptualized a modern-day interpretation of Petrushka in collaboration with Fort Worth Symphony which premiered in January 2024. He recently taught Modern Dance Masterclasses and choreographed an original work for the Boston Conservatory Summer Intensive in August 2024. Sean will be performing as a tap dancer in a SheDFW production of For Bo in September 2024. Sean is currently a Freelance Dancer/Choreographer/Teacher and will be on faculty at Joffrey Dallas and The DASH Academy for the 2024/2025 season.
