FINDING THE HISTORY OF QUAKERTOWN AT THE RICHLAND LIBRARY

Until it published its last edition in January 2009, a family-owned newspaper launched in 1881 called The Quakertown Free Press kept generations of residents living in and around Quakertown current on town happenings.

The archives of the newspaper are now a treasure trove of historical information. Thanks to an initiative of the Richland Library Company, these archives are being made available in an open, easy to use, searchable format.

The Richland Library Company, located at 44 S. Main Street, is a private library company dating back to 1788, making it one of the oldest in the country. It operated as a general lending library from its founding through the 1970s. Since 1993 it has focused on preserving items of genealogical and local interest, and in 2018 opened a new addition to house the Calvin Ruth Archive and Research Center. It is truly a local jewel for anyone researching local history.

The Library recently joined with the Richland Historical Society on this major project to create an online digital archive of the Quakertown Free Press. The archive currently is complete through 1945, and will continue to digitize additional years as funding allows.

The online archive is available to all internet users - no registration, login or fee of any kind - from the library’s website: richlandlibrary1788.org. Check it out!

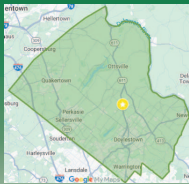

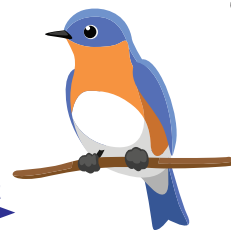

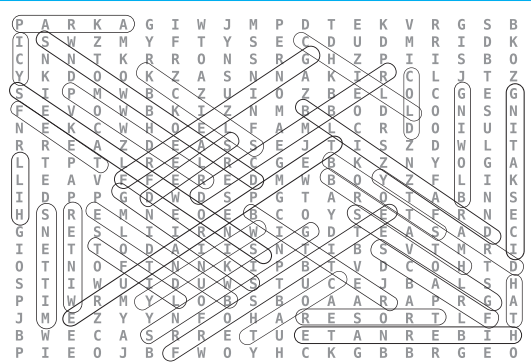

He was a proud U.S. Army veteran, having served in Germany during the Vietnam War.

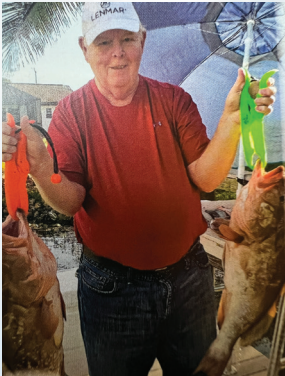

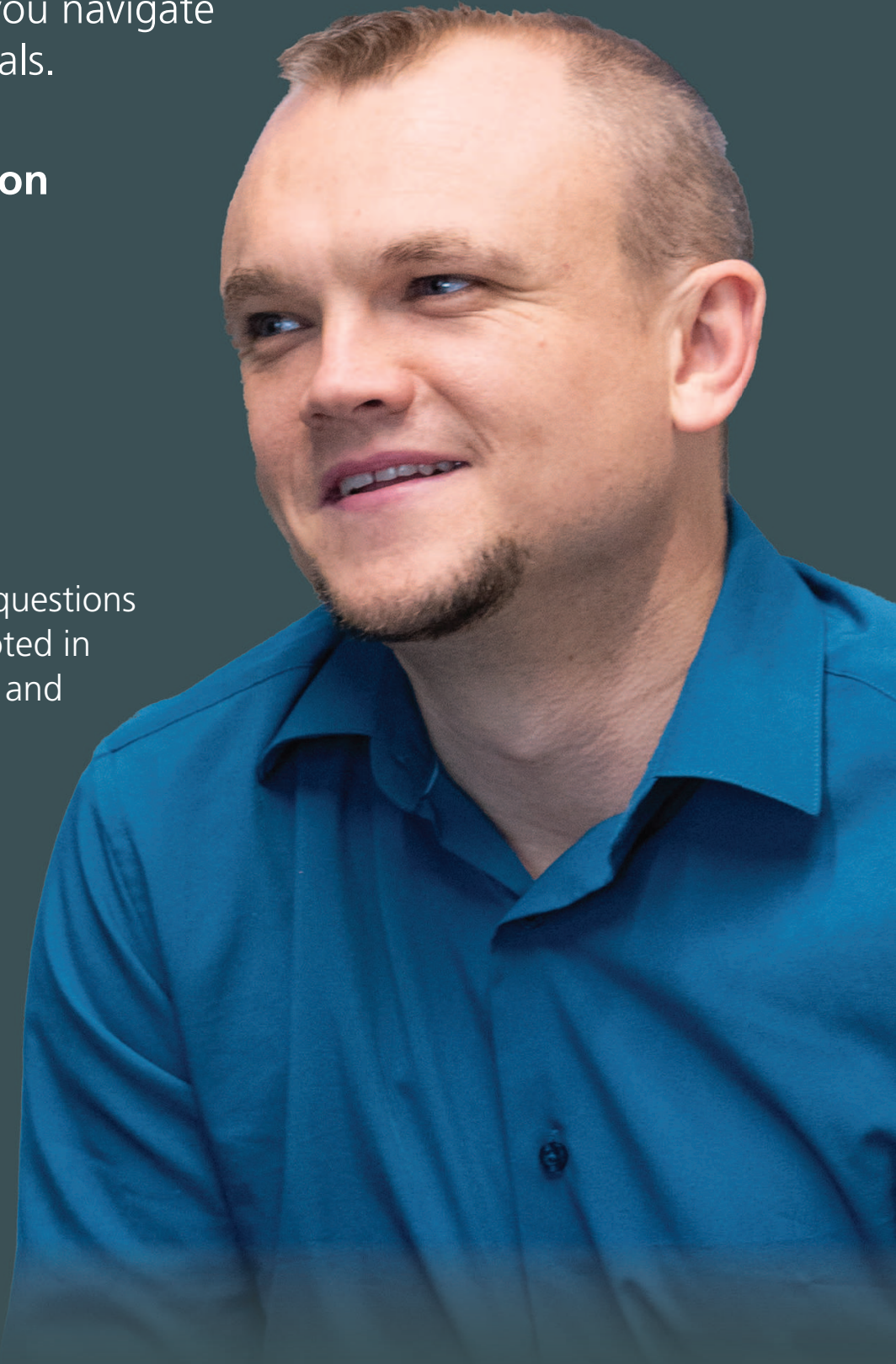
