1. OPEN DOORS

Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving; **Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance**, to speak the mystery of Christ for which I am also in bonds: —Colossians 4:2-3

2. BOLDNESS

And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, **that I may open my mouth boldly**, to make known the mystery of the gospel. —Ephesians 6:19

3. SPREAD OF THE WORD

Finally, brethren, pray for us, **that the word of the Lord may have free course**, and be glorified, even as it is with you. —2 Thessalonians 3:1

4. FRUITFULNESS IN MINISTRY

Herein is my Father glorified, **that ye bear much fruit**; so shall ye be my disciples. —1 John 15:8

5. PROTECTION

And that we may be **delivered from unreasonable and wicked men**: for all men have not faith. But the Lord is faithful, who shall establish you, and keep you from evil. —2 Thessalonians 3:2-3

Spiritual

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour. —1 Peter 5:8

Physical

Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and that all the Gentiles might hear: **and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion**. —1 Timothy 4:17

Moral

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: **but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able**; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it. —1 Corinthians 10:13

6. PROVISION

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, **always having all sufficiency in all things**, may abound to every good work. —2 Corinthians 9:8

Social

Wherefore **comfort yourselves together, and edify one another**, even as also ye do. —1 Thessalonians 5:11

Material

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving **let your requests be made known unto God**. —Philippians 4:6

Let your conversation be without covetousness; **and be content with such things as ye have**; for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. —Hebrews 13:5
